CAMPING REGULATIONS

FOR BERRY EQUESTRIAN CENTRE
39 SCHOFIELDS LANE, BERRY NSW 2535

Effective as of 01 August 2025

Berry Equestrian Centre offers only primitive camping. This means that there is no power available, and the only amenities provided are portaloos. Campers need to provide their own horse yards, which must be of metal construction - no tape yards are permitted.

Camping at Berry Equestrian Centre is offered to event participants under the following conditions:

- All camp sites are to be pre-booked, and pre-paid.
- No person is to be on site overnight unless registered for camping.
- Camp sites are booked per vehicle (ie horse float / truck / caravan).
- Camping is only permitted in the top paddock. There is no camping anywhere else on the grounds.
- Campers must display the provided camping permit on their vehicle at all times.

Further, the following rules apply:

- Open fires are not permitted at any time.
- Campers are responsible for all waste and are to leave their site clean and clear of any rubbish.
- Smoking and vaping is not permitted anywhere on the Berry Equestrian Centre grounds.
- Noise is to be kept to a minimum, with consideration for our neighbours and your fellow campers.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times, and owners must pick up after their dog. There is abundant wildlife as well as cattle on site, and dogs must be managed to prevent any issues.
- Glass is to be kept to a minimum. Alcohol is only to be consumed at individual campsites and is not to be taken to any other locations on site.
- Children 16 years and under must be accompanied by a parent or designated guardian at all times.
- Generators are permitted but users must be mindful of the noise.

In making a booking you are agreeing that yourself and all other campers at your site are bound by the conditions and rules stated above.
