CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

This event will run under EA/FEI rules. All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. Please ensure the safety of all children whilst in proximity to horses.

All horses competing in 1.05m height show jumping classes and above must hold FULL EA horse registration and EA State Show Jumping licence. Riders must be EA registered competitor members. All other competitors must be either current financial members of EA or Berry Riding Club. Join BRC via Nominate > Clubs. Event membership available. Horses in restricted height classes below 1.05m do not have to be EA registered.

No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct information and applicable fees for entries and rider levies.

RIGHTS OF ORGANISING COMMITTEE

The Organising Committee reserves the right to:

1. change or amend the program when deemed necessary
2. refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
3. make additional statements with regards to the rules/processes based on horse welfare and safety

SCRATCHING/REFUNDS OF ENTRIES

Refunds will be given up until close of entries through the Global system when made in writing via email only to the Event Secretary Judy Sweeney info@berryridingclub.com. Refunds will be considered after close of entries upon written submission to the Event Secretary (less a \$20.00 administration fee). No refunds will be given for horses that do not start in a class once the event has commenced unless a vet or doctor's certificate is produced.

CHANGE OF ENTRY/LATE ENTRY

No change of entries will be accepted after 4pm the day prior to the event. Late entries will be accepted if there is sufficient space in the class & a \$10 late fee is paid with the entry fee.

NUMBER OF CLASS STARTS

Horses may only start in a maximum of 3 classes per day.

Concurrent Competitions: Competitors may enter in concurrent competitions with different horses. Horses are only eligible to compete in one section eg – Class 2 (A or B or C), Class 3 (A or B), Class 9 (A or B or C).

THSA

All horses entering the thoroughbred class must have a TSHA licence. TSHA licences can be purchased on Global Entries Online. JUMPING NSW AMATEUR OF THE YEAR

All entries in the JNSW Amateur of the Year class must meet the rulings of EA Art.205.3.1. The class will be conducted in accordance with www.jumpingnsw.equestrian.org.au/content/amateur-jumping-series

DRAW

Ring 1 is to take priority over Ring 2. Both Rings will be run by strict draw order. The draw will be emailed to each competitor. To ensure fairness and a good flow of competitors, a rider with two horses in a competition must ensure he/she rides the first drawn horse first with a suitable time gap between each horse.

It is the competitor's responsibility to know their draw order and be ready to compete in order. If there is a clash in the other ring it is the competitor's responsibility to inform the gate marshal.

DRESS CODE

Formal dress rules apply as per EA Art. 207. Jackets must be worn for Ring 1 classes unless the EO decides otherwise. Any person mounted upon a horse must be wearing a properly secured tagged helmet, which must comply with EA standards. Helmet tagging will be available on the day

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

PRESENTATIONS

Mounted presentations will be conducted in each ring in front of the Judges Box at the completion of each class unless otherwise announced. Competitors must wear their correct attire.

PRIZE/MONEY

Prize money will be given during the mounted presentation at the completion of the class.

FIRST AID

After a fall anywhere on the Equestrian Centre, riders must not remount. It is compulsory for competitors to report to the First Aid Officer, located in the First Aid tent, for assessment before mounting.

AMBULANCE

In the event that an ambulance is called, the injured party is liable for any and/or medical costs.

STALLIONS

The Event Organiser (EO) follows the EA stallion code of conduct. Guardians of riders/handlers under 18 years must take responsibility for stallions at all times including when leading, riding or stabling stallions throughout the venue.

DOGS

Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and under effective control. Dogs are not permitted in the ring or warm up areas. All dog droppings to be picked up. Please be aware the Ranger may visit the Equestrian Centre daily.

CAMPING & POWERED SITES

Primitive camping is available at the Equestrian Centre. There are no powered sites, nor showers. Competitors are required to supply own metal yards, no tape/rope yards are permitted.

ABUSE

No abuse of horses, fellow competitors, officials or volunteers will be tolerated. The FEI Code of Conduct for the welfare of the horse is paramount. Failure to follow instruction from Berry Riding Club Committee members will result in disqualification from the event. The EA will be notified of such behaviour if deemed necessary by the OC.

HEALTH

Competitors are asked not to attend if they are feeling unwell.

SMOKING & VAPING

Smoking and vaping is prohibited at the Berry Equestrian Centre by order of the Shoalhaven City Council.

SAFETY & RISK MANAGEMENT

The EO shall address and act upon all safety issues at the event. Due to insurance issues and in the interest of all equestrian events, your attention to safety and cooperation with ground staff is requested. Competitors must ensure that all animals brought on to the grounds are free from any contagious or infectious disease.

ROAD SAFETY

Bicycles and unpowered (push) scooters must not be ridden by anyone without a helmet. Two-wheeled electric scooters are not permitted at the Equestrian Centre under any circumstance.

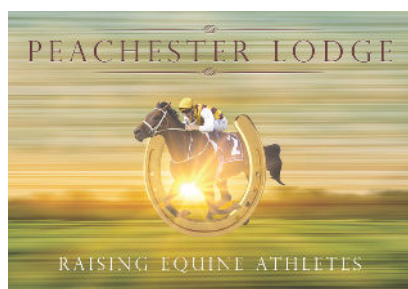
